West Davis Corridor Update

Both Alternatives A and B are being studied as part of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (Draft EIS). Currently, chapters of the Draft EIS document are being drafted and the team is conducting a comprehensive analysis on impacts such as noise, water quality, and air quality. The results of this in-depth analysis will be presented in the Draft EIS, which is expected to be released in spring 2013, along with a public hearing process. A final Record of Decision is not expected until the study is complete in 2014.
