## Mayor's Message

### What is Happening in West Point?

Now that we are midway through the year (already!) I thought I would take this opportunity to inform you of some of the things happening in our City and the surrounding areas. This is a busy time of year with our awesome Independence Day celebration, and also all that comes with those orange cones on some of our roadways. While the road construction can get frustrating and tiresome, I do have some good news for those of you who are wanting another eating option in our City – Culver's Restaurant is finishing up their approval process with the City Council and should be starting construction soon. If you are like me, you may have never heard of Culver's, much less eaten there. Culver's is a nationwide franchise that was started in 1984 and now has more than 600 locations; ours, however, will be the first one built north of Salt Lake City. Culver's menu features their trademark ButterBurgers and [frozen custard](#) (which I am happy to report is also sold in bulk). They will be building on the corner of 300 N and 2000 W just east of the Smith's fuel center. The plans show a really nice building and they will be a great addition to our commercial area around Smith's Marketplace.

Along with Culver's, a new office building similar to the one just south of Del Taco will be built on the corner of 300 N and 3000 W. They are also finishing with all the approvals and should be starting construction soon.

For those of you who don't know, we accepted applications the first part of June for our upcoming Municipal Election this November. This year we have two City Council seats open along with my Mayor's seat. Fun fact - all of the mayors in Davis County and for most of the State are on the same election cycle and will be running this fall. This year, three individuals filed for the two City Council seats and I will be the only one on the ballot this year for Mayor. So like it or not, you are stuck with me for another four years. All the cities in Davis County will be having vote-by-mail elections (similar to the General Election held last year), and I encourage all of you to educate yourself on the candidates and submit your ballots. We will not be having a primary election (regularly in August) this year, so look for more information coming as we get closer to November 7th.

Have you had a chance to make it out to our Movies in the Park? If you haven't made it to one yet don't worry as you still have a couple more chances. On July 28<sup>th</sup> and August 11<sup>th</sup> we will once again show a movie at Loy Blake Park and invite food trucks to come make dinner for you. Combine that with the awesome playground, this is a great event to keep the kids entertained while parents relax with neighbors and friends on a hot summer night.

## WEST POINT MILITARY MEMORIAL

My most favorite time of the year is the month of July – the two biggest parades most of see are in July as we celebrate our Nation and our State. One of my favorite patriotic poems, called *Hats Off*, in part says this:
